- 7. The graduation credits of F.5 Education System students are required to increase at least 12 credits.
- 8. In accordance with the regulations of KNU interdisciplinary learning, students of this very department are required to take interdisciplinary program, double minor, or double major, in order to fulfill graduation threshold.
